The Connector enables you to automate sending and retrieving content from your Adobe Experience Manager CMS, which dramatically reduces the effort required to create, maintain, and publish Web content in multiple languages

### System Requirements

The Clay Tablet Connector for Adobe Experience Manager ("AEM") must be installed on the AEM Author server. The Clay Tablet Connector for AEM supports AEM versions 5.6.1 and higher.

The Clay Tablet Connector for AEM has no additional hardware or software requirements beyond those of AEM. For detailed requirements, refer to the appropriate version of the *Adobe Experience Manager Technical Requirements*.

## What's New?

- In the **Status** tab of the **Translation Status** window, you can now concurrently delete multiple translation jobs from the Connector, so that they are no longer displayed.
- You can now specify workflows for SDL TMS from within the Connector.
- When the Freeway add-on is installed:
  - ▣ In the **Bulk Translation** wizard, you can now specify the `Queue Metadata` analysis code of items you send for translation before sending them to the **Translation Queue**.
  - ▣ In the **Translation Queue**, you can now view an item by the `Queue Metadata` analysis code and filter all items by the `Queue Metadata` analysis code.

## Issues Fixed in This Release

Issue ID	Description
AEM-415	Previously, if a user was deleted after sending out a job for translation, this prevented the <b>Translation Status</b> window from displaying properly. This issue has been resolved.
AEM-579	Previously, when using AEM 5.6.1, the <b>Status</b> tab of the <b>Translation Status</b> window did not load information about translation jobs. Errors about illegal characters were included in the log file. This issue has been resolved.
AEM-580	Multi-value content nodes in the source XML sent out for translation violated the DTD. This issue has been resolved.
AEM-586	Users assigned to the <code>Translation Admin</code> user group can now view jobs in the <b>Status</b> tab of the <b>Translation Status</b> window that are submitted by users assigned to the <code>Translation Submitter</code> who were not assigned to a team. Previously, users assigned to this user group did not see the jobs submitted by users assigned to the <code>Translation Submitter</code> who were not assigned to a team.
