What's New?

- In the **Languages** tab of the **New Translation** dialog box, you can now:
 - ▣ Click the new **Select All** button to select all target languages for translation.
 - ▣ Select the new **All** check box beside the **Segment has source content** column to select all the check boxes in this column.
- In both the **Translation Job** tab of the **New Translation** dialog box and the **Send Out Queued Items** dialog box, you can now select the new **Token – Automatically translate referenced tokens** check box to automatically include referenced tokens in a translation job. If this is selected for a job, then in the **Translation Jobs** tab, the new **ATRT** (Auto Translate Referenced Tokens) column displays *Yes*.
- In the **Translation Jobs** tab:
 - ▣ You can now un-archive previously archived jobs.
 - ▣ You can now resend a job. When resending a previously sent job, you can modify the assets to include, source and target languages, translation provider, translation options, and job options in the new **Resend Translation** dialog box.
- You can no longer send the **Email Script** token for translation, because Marketo no longer supports this.
