Overview

Welcome to the Clay Tablet Connector for Oracle WebCenter Sites ("Connector"). The Connector enables you to automate sending and retrieving content from your Oracle WebCenter Sites CMS, which dramatically reduces the effort required to create, maintain, and publish Web content in multiple languages

System Requirements

The Clay Tablet Connector for Oracle WebCenter Sites ("OWCS") supports OWCS versions 11.1.1.6.1 and 11.1.1.8.

The Clay Tablet Connector for OWCS has no additional hardware or software requirements beyond those of OWCS. For detailed requirements, refer to the appropriate version of the OWCS documentation at http://www.oracle.com/technetwork/middleware/webcenter/sites/documentation/index.html.

What's New?

- The new CTSiteAdmin role enables administrative access to specified sites, while the CTAdmin role enables global setup and access for all sites. For detailed setup instructions, refer to the Clay Tablet Connector for Oracle WebCenter Sites Installation and Configuration Guide.
- Users assigned to the CTSiteAdmin and CTAdmin roles now view jobs in the Translation Jobs page and assets in the Translation Queue for only one site at a time.
- When importing a configuration, users can now choose whether to overwrite an existing configuration or to merge a configuration, which means to overwrite only previously exported configuration settings.
- The Connector can now read Freeway analysis codes for a Freeway-type translation connector. You can use the import-configuration functionality, available only to users with the CTAdmin role, to edit the analysis codes to display in the WCS.freewayAnalysisCodeConfigs file. When importing this file, ensure that the Merge with existing configuration check box is selected. For instructions about importing configuration files, refer to the Clay Tablet Connector for Oracle WebCenter Sites Installation and Configuration Guide.
