Welcome to the Lionbridge Connector for SAP Commerce (Connector). The Connector enables you to automate sending and retrieving content from your SAP Commerce CMS, which dramatically reduces the effort required to create, maintain, and publish Web content in multiple languages.

System Requirements

The Lionbridge Connector for SAP Commerce ("Connector") supports:

- Hybris versions 6.1 and higher
- SAP Commerce versions 18xx, 19xx, and higher
- SAP Commerce Cloud versions 18xx, 19xx, and higher

The Connector has several pre-installation requirements, described in "Before You Install" in the *Lionbridge Connector for SAP Commerce Installation and Configuration Guide*.

- On Hybris or SAP Commerce, the Connector requires Java 8.
- On SAP Commerce Cloud 19xx or higher, the Connector requires sapmachine-jdk-11 or oracle-jdk-11.

The Connector has no additional hardware or software requirements beyond those of SAP Commerce.

Memory	16 GB minimum is recommended by SAP Commerce. This is recommended for the Connector to function as expected.
Disk Space	<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ 5 GB is recommended by SAP Commerce.■ The Connector installation requires an additional 170 MB of disk space.■ Space for storing log files.

What's New?

- The Connector no longer supports the Lionbridge onDemand translation provider, which has been discontinued.
- There have been back-end improvements to how the Connector saves content-mapping configurations.

Issues Fixed in This Release

Issue ID	Description
LHYB-405	<p>In earlier versions of the Connector, while adding more attributes to a previously mapped type, the previously added attributes were removed from the mapping. This issue has been resolved: Adding more attributes to a previously mapped type no longer removes the previously added attributes from the mapping.</p> <p>Important: Upgrading the Connector database is required when updating your Connector installation from version 2.1.x-2.4.0 to the current version. This is required to support changes to how classification content mapping is saved in the Connector database. For detailed instructions, refer to the <i>Lionbridge Connector for SAP Commerce Installation and Configuration Guide</i>.</p>
LHYB-409	<p>In version 2.4.0 of the Connector, saving content mappings in SAP Commerce Cloud version 1905.2 displayed an error message. This issue has been resolved.</p>

Known Issues

Issue ID	Description
LHYB-318	<p>In the Translation Settings section of the System Configuration page, if the Maximum number of items per translation file or the Cron Job Interval (Minutes) settings has a value greater than 9999999999, an <code>Out of range</code> error message is displayed.</p>
LHYB-368	<p>When sending content for translation from the Hybris Product Cockpit or the Hybris WCMS Cockpit, the <code>SendToTranslationComposer</code> error message is written to the <code>Claytablet.log</code> log file. However, the Connector sends the content for translation normally.</p>
LHYB-373	<p>You cannot send the metadata of classification attributes for translation. For example, you cannot send the description of the <code>ProductFeature</code> product attribute for translation. This limitation occurs because this functionality is not supported by the Hybris API.</p>
